

Working at Height 2011 Campaign

– HLE Pulau Bukom Site

Hai Leck Engineering Pte Ltd has successfully kicked off the Working at Height 2011 Campaign at our Pulau Bukom site on 20 May 2011. This safety campaign is part of our continuous efforts to enhance safety awareness.



As part of the campaign launch, an awareness program was held and attended by all our staff from the Hai Leck-Bukom site. Besides the support of the site management, our corporate management were also present to give their support. This event was also attended by representatives from SEPL led by the HSSEQ Manager and Project & Turnaround Manager. Other guests include safety coaches from the different Production Units and our contractor colleagues. Everyone participated in the safety pledge signing of “No Hook, No Work”.

One of the lineup includes a demonstration to highlight the importance of permit application, risk assessment, pre use inspection & proper donning of harness, checking of scaffold tag, three point contact when using the ladder, proper anchoring of harness, supervision & communication and rescue plan. In addition, alternative methods of anchoring such as use of horizontal lifelines, web slings and self retractable fall arrester were also demonstrated.

To drive home the important message of the dangers involved while working at height, demonstrations on dummy drop with and without safety harness were conducted. Each worker was given the chance to experience the feeling of being suspended in a harness so that they can better appreciate how the proper use of a relief loop can prevent the onset of suspension trauma. As a part of our proactive initiatives, every scaffolder has been issued a suspension trauma relief loop and each worker will also undergo a Working at Height awareness classroom training.

In Hai Leck, working at height is inherent in our daily activities. Everyday, our workers are exposed to the hazards associated with working at height and we believe that all accidents in the workplace can be prevented if proper training and safety measures are put in place. The successful launch of this campaign is a strong indicator of our company’s commitment in making our workplace safer for our valued workers.
